Purpose of Project:

The Eagle River Road is a Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (3R) project. The purpose of this 3R project is to extend the service life of the road and enhance both safety and capacity. The Eagle River Road Rehabilitation project involves resurfacing, and widening of the current road based on an ongoing analysis of the crash history. The project begins at upper Terrance Drive at MP 5.3 and continues to the end of the paved roadway at MP 12.6 where the Eagle River Nature Center is located.
